

Isolate Packing & Shipping Checklist

- O Select the isolate to be shipped for use in preparing your autogenous product.
 - o Isolates must be cultures of United States origin.
 - O Vaxxinova has approval to accept domestic bacterial cultures for autogenous production. However, USDA rules prohibit anyone shipping certain bacteria, which are in the CDC's list of Category A in infectious agents. Category A agents on the CDC's list, as of January 1, 2010, are Bacillus anthracis, Clostridium botulinum, Yersinia pestis and Francisella tularensis. (Note: the CDC's current list of Category A agents can be checked on-line at https://www.bt.cdc.gov/agent/agentlist-category.asp)
- Prepare and pack the isolate(s)
 - Check with your carrier to determine any special packing and labeling requirements. The following are Vaxxinova guidelines for packing isolates.
 - Each isolate should be submitted as a pure freshly grown (16 48 hour) agar culture. Best shipping results are obtained by shipping on an agar slant in a screw cap tube. A pure agar plate culture is also acceptable. Tryptic soy and blood agar work best, but any non-inhibitory agar tube/plate is acceptable.
 - Label each tube/plate with the customer name, organism, identification, and date of inoculation of the tube/plate.
 - o Seal the tube/plate with masking tape or parafilm.
 - Wrap each tube/plate in absorbent material (sheet cotton or paper toweling) so that in the event of crushing of the package, the liquid content of the tube/plate could be completely absorbed by this material.
 - O Place the sealed wrapped tube/plate inside a crush-proof container (such as a metal canister) and seal the lid of the crush-proof container with masking tape or parafilm.
 - Pack the sealed container into a cardboard or Styrofoam shipping box, with appropriate ice packs for the season. Dry ice is not used for shipping agar cultures.
- Attach a copy of the current USDA shipping permit located on our website onto the shipping documents which will accompany the shipment on the outside of the shipping box.
- o Fill out and attach a copy of the diagnostic submission form
- Ship promptly (ship only on Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday via next day delivery to:
